Teen Marketing Partner Program

The Citizens Deposit Bank Teen Marketing Partner Program is a scholarship program for upcoming Junior & Senior students. The Program was developed to support students in CDB's local communities; providing them with opportunities to serve & shadow to grow into better leaders & professionals. Citizens Deposit Bank aims to select two students from Carlisle, Ballard, and Hickman County Schools (6 students total) to serve as a part of the Teen Marketing Partner Team each school year.

Applications are sent to area schools in April and may be picked up in the school guidance office. TMPs are chosen by a selections committee within Citizens Deposit Bank. TMPs will attend 5 meetings during their term of service. They are as follows:

- Orientation- This first meeting will serve as an overview of the TMP program for the coming year.
- Professional Development- This will be one of three "focus meetings" in which we will highlight career skills, and interpersonal relationships.
- Marketing-This meeting will focus on the importance of networking and basic marketing.
- Community Service- During this meeting, we will explain the importance of giving back to the local community.
- Final Luncheon- We will end the program with a final luncheon and recap the TMP Team's year of service.

TMPs will hear from a variety of speakers during each meeting that contribute to their growth as a leader & professional. They will also have the opportunity to participate in a variety of community service events and quarterly projects to apply the skills learned in each meeting.

Upon completion of the program, Teen Marketing Partners will be awarded a \$500 scholarship to the post-secondary institution they plan to attend. The scholarship will be awarded at each student's Senior Awards Program.
